At 2,160 grams per set, these aren't the lightest 29er wheels out there, but 28-millimeter-wide rims make them among the fattest. The set shown here is hand-built around Velocity hubs using DT Swiss double-buttet spokes and Veloplugs, which weigh half as much as traditional cloth rimstrips.



## FIZIK GOBI XM

The redesigned Gobi XM sports a flattened profile for a broader sitting area. Despite the changes, it retains the popular Wing Flex and Tail Flex features that create a little give in the saddle while pedaling, yet still provide a comfortable, supportive base.

This sexy-simple headset boasts 17-millimeters' worth of interlocking spacers and a compression ring that snaps into the top bearing cover. Good looking and long lasting, the 110 comes with a 110-year warranty, thanks to 7050+ alloy cups (15 percent stronger than 7075) and innovative split-lip seals on its bearings.



## FSA GRAVITY LIGHT BAR AND STEM

With top DH racers favoring custom-made extra-wide bars, it was only a matter of time before production models followed. FSA's Gravity Light Bar has a massive 800-millimeter (31.5-inch) span and is triple butted to keep strength up and weight at a minimum. Pair it with this sub-200-gram forged and machined stem to lighten the load.
